Currently, the pilot is deployed at six KCLS libraries: Federal Way (2), Bothell, Kenmore, Vashon, and Kingsgate. The pilot will end in December 2011.

Bill updated us on his meeting with the transportation manager. The city of Bellevue has agreed that one of the three bus slots at the Bellevue library will be available for loading and unloading after 10am everyday.
