

## Notice of Public Hearing- Sale of the Snoqualmie Library Property

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Trustees of the King County Library System will be holding an open public hearing on Tuesday, December 19, 2006, at approximately 4:00 pm at the King County Library System Administrative and Service Center Board Room, 960 Newport Way NW, Issaquah, Washington, 98027, for the purpose of hearing comments from the public on the proposed sale of the current Snoqualmie Library, located at 38580 SE River Street, Snoqualmie, Washington, 98065. By Resolution No. 2006-06, the Board of Trustees has declared the Snoqualmie Library property as surplus and intends to sell the property to the City of Snoqualmie. The City of Snoqualmie currently intends to use the facility for general municipal use. The King County Library System will continue to operate the library at this location until the new library to be located in the City of Snoqualmie is completed and ready for occupancy in 2007. Comments on the proposed sale will be heard from all interested parties attending the hearing. Testimony should be limited to no more than five minutes per interested party. After all oral testimony is received the meeting will be adjourned. Written comments will be accepted prior to the hearing until December 18, 2006 at 5:00 pm at the King County Library Service Center, 960 Newport Way NW, Issaquah, Washington or by email to Kathy Svajdenka (svajdlen@kcls.org).
