The subject project is described in the Contract Documents and generally includes asphalt paving, utilities, landscaping, site preparation for new addition, concrete foundations, metal wall framing, masonry veneer, structural steel and glue-laminated beam roof framing, metal decking, modified bituminous sheet membrane and sheet metal roofing, specialties, and mechanical and electrical systems. The project site is located at 27100 164th Ave SE, Covington, WA 98042.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the project site on Wednesday January 10, 2007 at 1:00 P.M.

Contractors may obtain Bidding and Contract Documents at Reprographics Northwest Inc. upon deposit of a check in the amount of \$25.00 per set. The deposit will only be accepted in the form of a check made payable to the King County Library System. Deposit will be returned to Bidders upon return of the documents in good condition within six (6) calendar days of the Bid Opening.

General Contractors may obtain 2 sets maximum on deposit. Prime Mechanical and Electrical contractors may obtain 1 set on deposit. Subcontractors and those needing additional sets or partial sets may purchase them at cost (not refundable) from the printer.

Cost of delivery of shipping for both full sets and partial sets are additional and are to be paid directly to the printer and are not refundable.

A bidder awarded the contract (or its Mechanical and Electrical subcontractors) may retain the bidding documents, and its deposit will be refunded.

Document holders not returning documents within six (6) calendar days after the Bid Opening shall forfeit their deposit.

Bid, Bid Bond and other enclosures shall be enclosed in an opaque sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the Bidder and addressed to the Owner per Section 00100. Mark lower left corner of the envelope "Covington Library Addition and Modernization Bid".

No bidder may withdraw its bid after the hour set for opening unless and until award of the contract has been delayed for a period of sixty (60) days.

King County Library System reserves the right to reject all bids for any or no reason, to waive informalities and irregularities, to reject any bid not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Contract Documents, and to postpone the award of the Contract for a period of time not greater than sixty (60) days from the bid opening date.
