Bid, Bid Bond and other enclosures shall be enclosed in an opaque sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the Bidder and addressed to the Owner per Section 00100. Mark lower left corner of the envelope "BURIEN LIBRARY PROJECT – PSESD DEMOLITION BID".

No bidder may withdraw its bid after the hour set for opening unless and until award of the contract has been delayed for a period of sixty (60) days.
