

Install Adobe Digital Editions* On Your Personal Computer

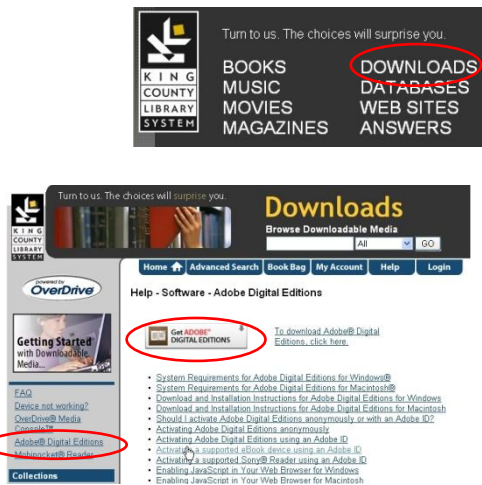
- *Required to download, read, & transfer Adobe PDF and EPUB eBooks from KCLS OverDrive collection.
- *Works on Windows & Apple OSX (Apple steps may vary slightly).
- *Requires Adobe Flash player (already installed on most computers).
- *Adobe Digital Editions must be installed and activated

BEFORE you download any **Adobe PDF and EPUB eBooks**.

1. Visit www.kcls.org and click **DOWNLOADS**.
2. Scroll down and under **eBooks**, click **Overdrive**.
3. On the left side of the screen, click the link for **"Adobe® Digital Editions"**



4. Click **Get ADOBE® DIGITAL EDITIONS** which will take you to the Adobe web site to install Digital Editions.



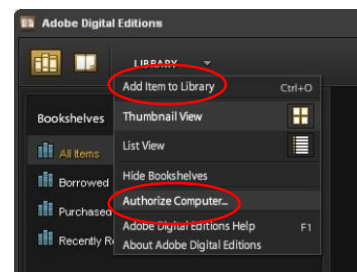
5. If you don't already have the correct version of Flash, you will first be prompted to install Flash. Click and follow instructions to install. Then start over with Step #1.



6. Otherwise, on the Digital Editions page, scroll down and click the **Install button** and follow on-screen instructions. Most users will want to accept all the default install options.



7. Digital Editions will open. Click on **Library** and then choose **Authorize Computer** from the drop down menu. Authorization allows you to copy the same eBook to multiple computers and portable devices, such as Sony Readers or Barnes & Noble Nook. Up to six computers/devices can be authorized. (Sorry, Amazon Kindle is not compatible.)



8. If you already have an **Adobe ID**, sign in with your ID/password and click **Authorize** button. If you don't have an ID, click on the link **"get an Adobe ID online"**, then click the **Create an Adobe Account** button. Follow the instructions and then return to the Adobe Digital Editions window and **sign in with your new Adobe ID** (usually based on your email address).



9. Now you are ready to return to the KCLS OverDrive **DOWNLOADS** collection, <http://ebooks.kcls.org>, to checkout and download Adobe PDF or Adobe EPUB eBooks.



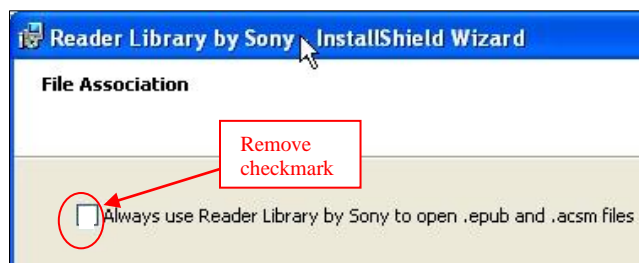
Transfer Adobe PDF & EPUB eBooks** To Sony Readers, Barnes & Noble Nook, Or Other Compatible Devices

- **Requires previous installation of Adobe Digital Editions and download of PDF/EPUB ebook (see page 1).
- **Requires Adobe Digital Editions to be authorized with Adobe ID and not anonymously (see page 1).

1. If you are using a compatible **Sony Reader**, you must first install the **Sony Reader Library** software.

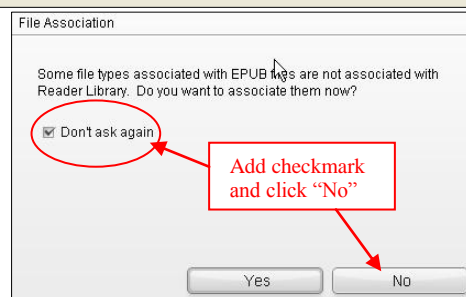
a. This software can be found on the reader itself (device appears like USB flash drive on your computer and folder contains setup software for Reader Library) or you can **download** from Sony at <http://ebookstore.sony.com/download/>.

b. During install it may ask if you want to **“Always use Reader Library by Sony to open .epub and .acsm files.”** We recommend you **remove** the checkmark from this option.



Failure to remove this checkmark may cause conflicts with Adobe Digital Editions.

c. In addition, when you run the program it will ask you to associate EPUB files with Reader Library. Again, we recommend you choose **“No”** and add a checkmark to the **“Don’t ask again”** box to avoid this popup in the future.



2. Before transferring ebooks to the device, it must be **activated** with your Adobe ID. To do this, **open Adobe Digital Editions and then plug in your device**.

The first time you do this, the **“Device Setup Assistant”** dialog box is displayed and you will need to click **“Authorize Device”**. Note: if you have books on your device that were purchased/authorized using a different Adobe ID, then those books will stop working on your reader if you activate with a new Adobe ID.

3. To **transfer an eBook** to the portable device, **open Adobe Digital Editions and plug in your eReader**. If Sony Reader Library automatically opens, just close it.

4. Click the **Library View** button and find the book you wish to transfer.

5. **Click the desired book and hold and drag** it over to the left and **drop** it onto the name of your **eReader** (located at bottom of list of Bookshelves).

6. Transfer usually takes only a few seconds.

7. Close Adobe Digital Editions, disconnect your eReader from the computer, and enjoy.
