3. Literacy*AmeriCorps alumni describe our program as very rewarding, but also challenging, given the nature of our mission and the financial limitations of our grant. Many members find they need to make a lifestyle adjustment to make their service year successful. In addition, our program is only able to hire one person per AmeriCorps position (we do not have funding to re-hire for a position if someone dropped out, which would cause a break in important services). For all of these reasons, we ask that applicants think carefully about whether or not they can make a commitment to our program. Can you make a commitment to a full year of service in the Seattle area, beginning in September 2008? Please explain your response.
4. What plans do you have for making ends meet on such a limited income for the year in an expensive part of the country? Do you have friends or relatives in Seattle? Would you be able to find housing before September 1, 2008?
